Division Two (Kowloon) - Arrangement of Knock Out Finals

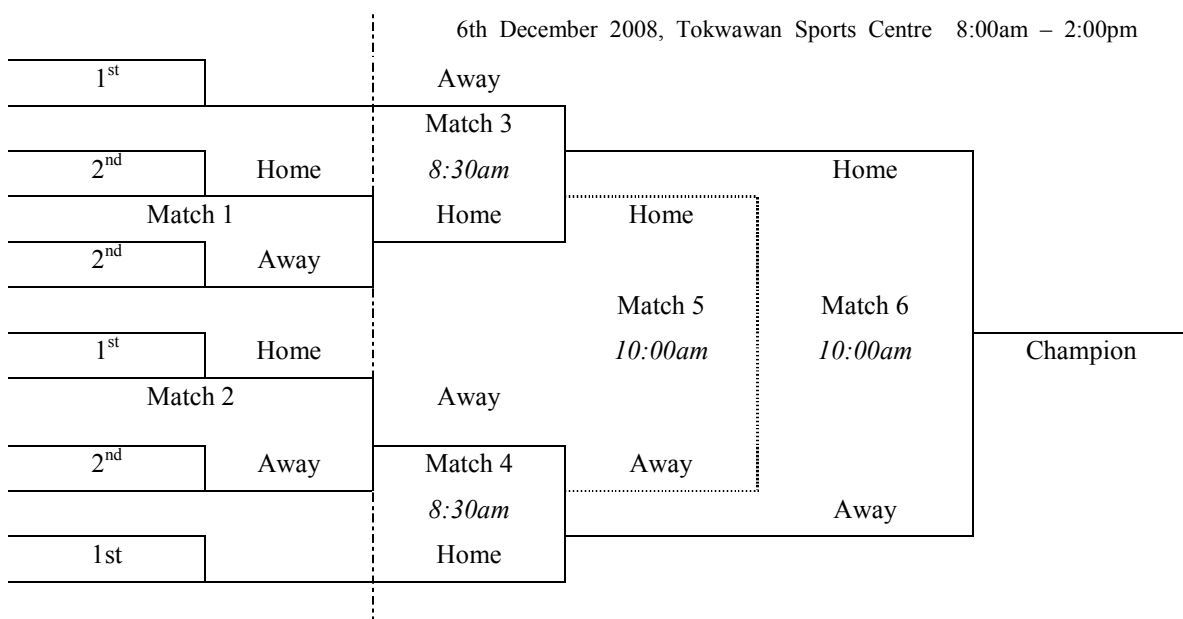
1. Kowloon Badminton Division Two finals will be in Single Knock Out Format. Top two teams in each group will qualify for the final.

2. Competition Schedule:

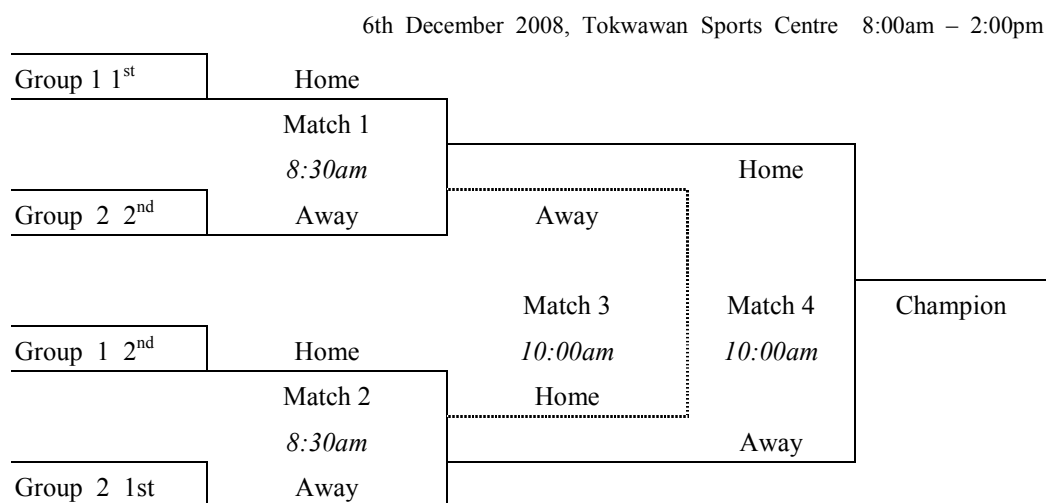
Division Two Boys A and B Grade Final: 6th December 2008, Tokwawan Sports Centre

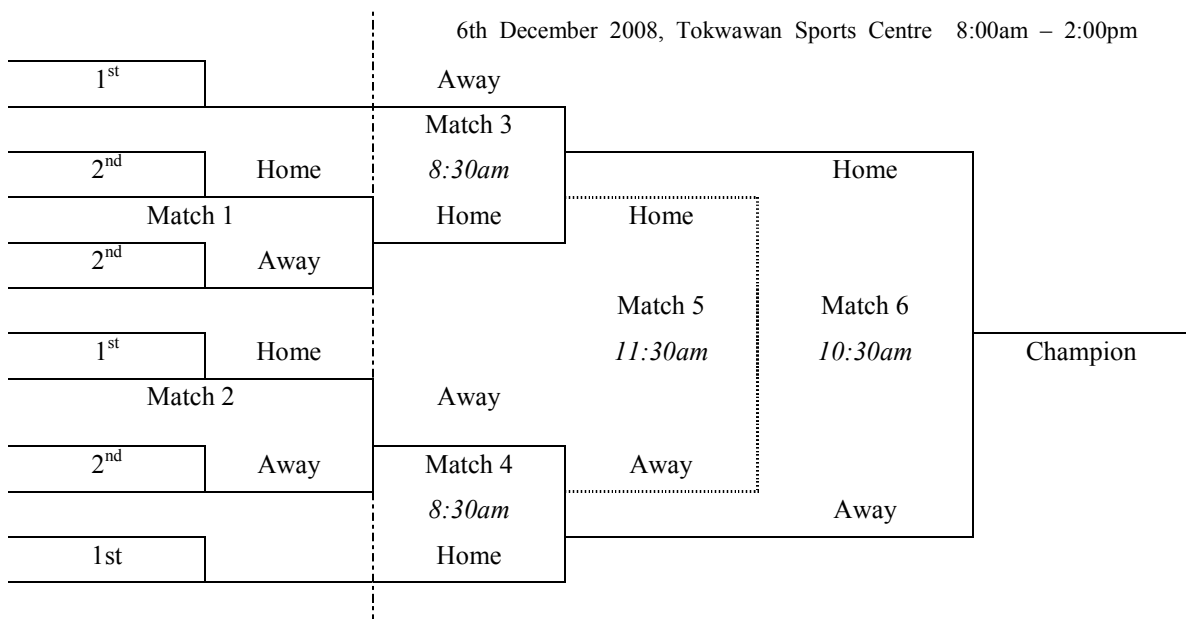
3.1 Division Two Boys A Grade Final:

4. The Match 1 and Match 2 of Division Two Boys A, B Grade and Girls B Grade will be held in weekdays before 3rd December 2008. Therefore all preliminary matches must be completed on or before 24th November.
5. Semi Finals and Finals of all Grades will be held on 6th December at Tokwawan Sports Centre.
6. Umpires of Hong Kong Badminton Association will be invited to officiate at the finals on 6th December at Tokwawan Sports Centre but confirmation is yet to come. Even neutral umpires can be available; each school will still be required to provide 2 linesmen for each match.
7. The booking hours of 6th December at Tokwawan Sports Centre are from 8:00am to 2:00pm and the first match of each day will commence at 8:30am sharp.
8. Schools may come earlier before commencement of the each day's first match to have practices. The time for the second match is for indication only. The second match will commence as soon as the match before has been completed.
9. Shuttlecocks and score sheets will be delivered to home teams on 6th December at the venue but all schools should bring extra shuttlecocks in case all officials shuttlecocks have been used up.
10. Please remind all supporters to stay on the Spectators' Stand.
11. Prize Presentation will be held immediately after the finals on 6th December.
