#### Competition Starting Time

Teams shall be properly dressed and have their score sheets filled in before the scheduled time of the match. If any team is not ready to start at the scheduled time, the referee may declare a walk-over.

#### 5. Teams

- 6.1 No more than 12 team members entitled to play, including a captain.
- 6.2 Each team member shall wear a shirt numbered on the front and back with plain numbers of a solid colour contrasting with the colour of the shirt.
- 6.3 **Teams shall use numbers from one (1) to fifteen (15).**

#### 6. Team Colour

- 7.1 The first team named in the fixture (home team) shall wear light-coloured shirts.
  - 7.2 The second team named in the fixture (away team) shall wear dark-coloured shirts.
  - 7.3 However, if two teams involved agree, they may interchange the colour of the shirts.
  - 7.4 Light-colour means white or yellow colour.
  - 7.5 Teams may wear other colour shirts irrespective of the rules above provided that the colour will not clash with the colour of the opposing team and prior consent of the opposing team has been sought.
  - 7.6 In the case of controversy on similar colour, the match referee's decision is final.
7. All Hong Kong Schools Jing Ying Tournament. The Tournament will be held on 19/12/2011 – 23/12/2011. A quota system will apply as follows :
